

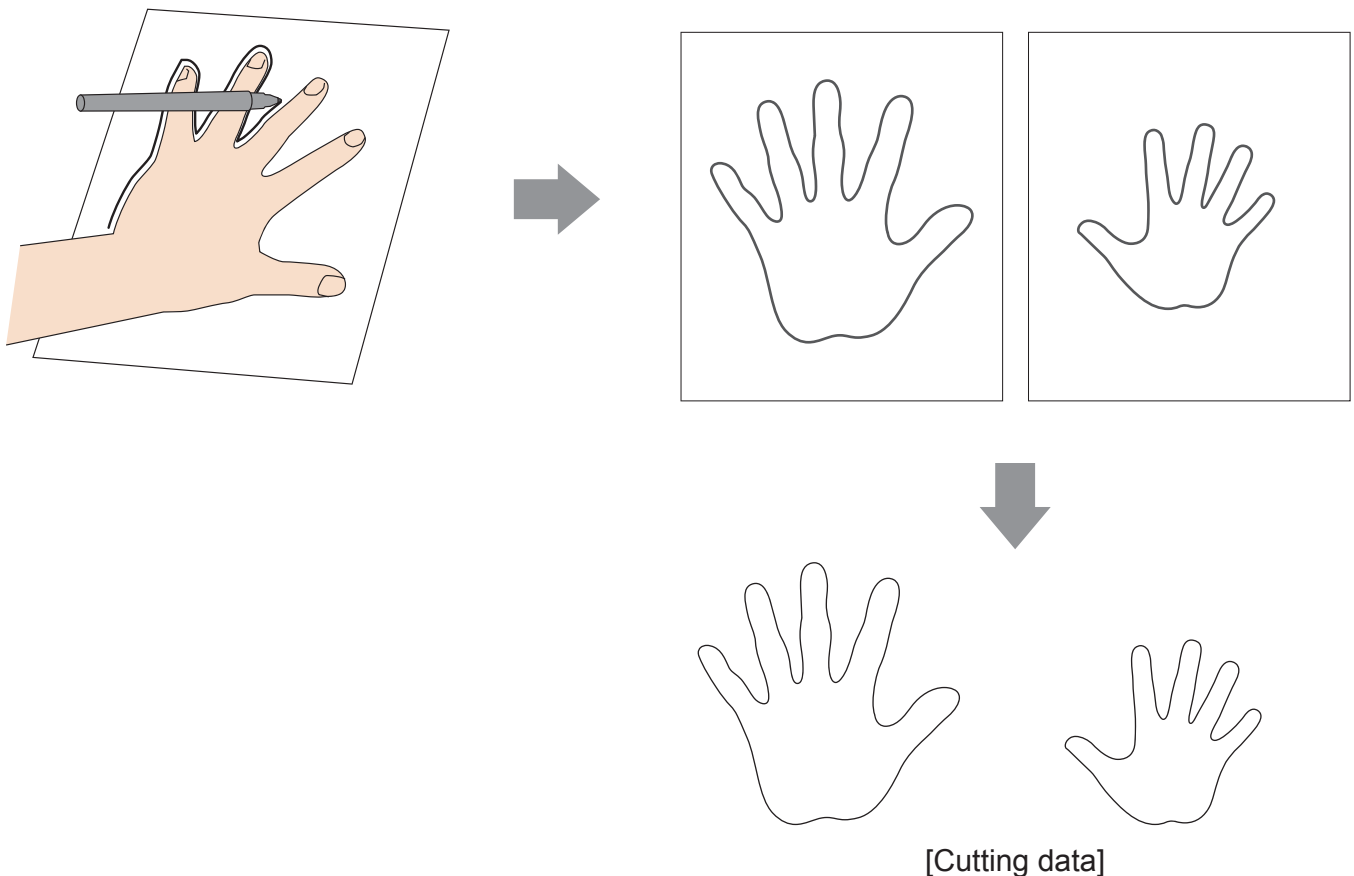
000164. Aprons for Adult and Child



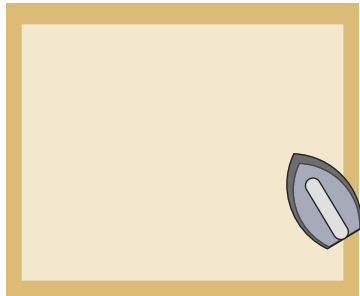
Material

Apron – 2 (for adult & for child)
 Iron-on transfer sheet (White)
 Appliqué fabric – 3 kinds (adult hand, child hand & chef's hats)
 Stencil Sheet
 Iron-on Fabric Appliqué Contact Sheet
 Fabric paint (brown)
 Stencil sponge brush
 Black felt-tip pen
 White paper (for drawing hands)

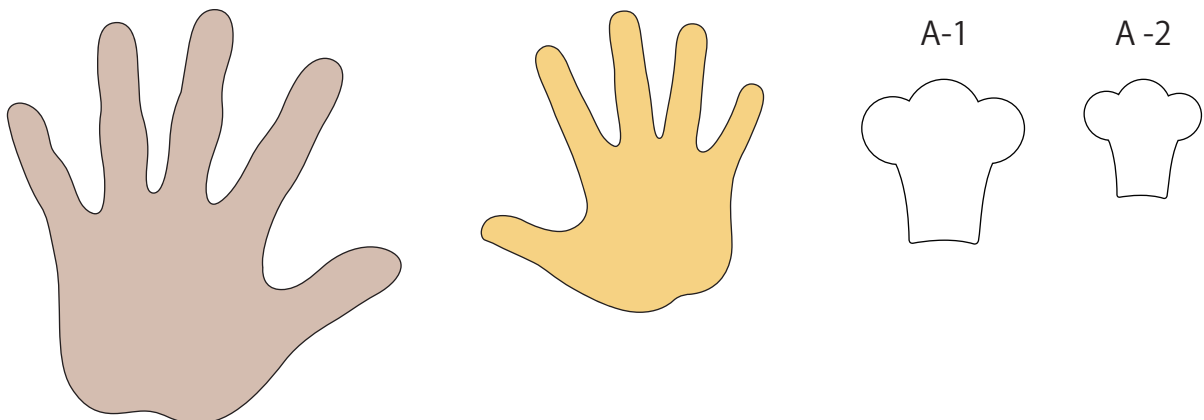
(1) Use the black felt-tip pen to trace the adult and child hands onto the white paper. Clearly draw the lines so they are not interrupted. Touch the “Scan” key, and then select “Scan to Cut Data” to create and save the cutting data.



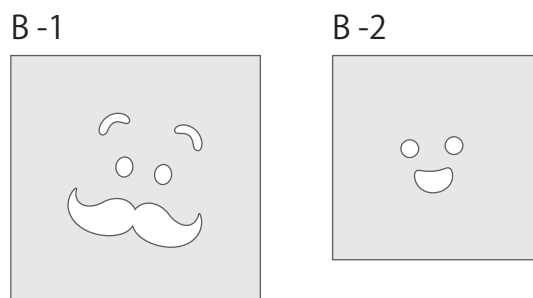
(2) Attach iron-on fabric appliqué contact sheet to the back of each of the three kinds of appliqué fabric.



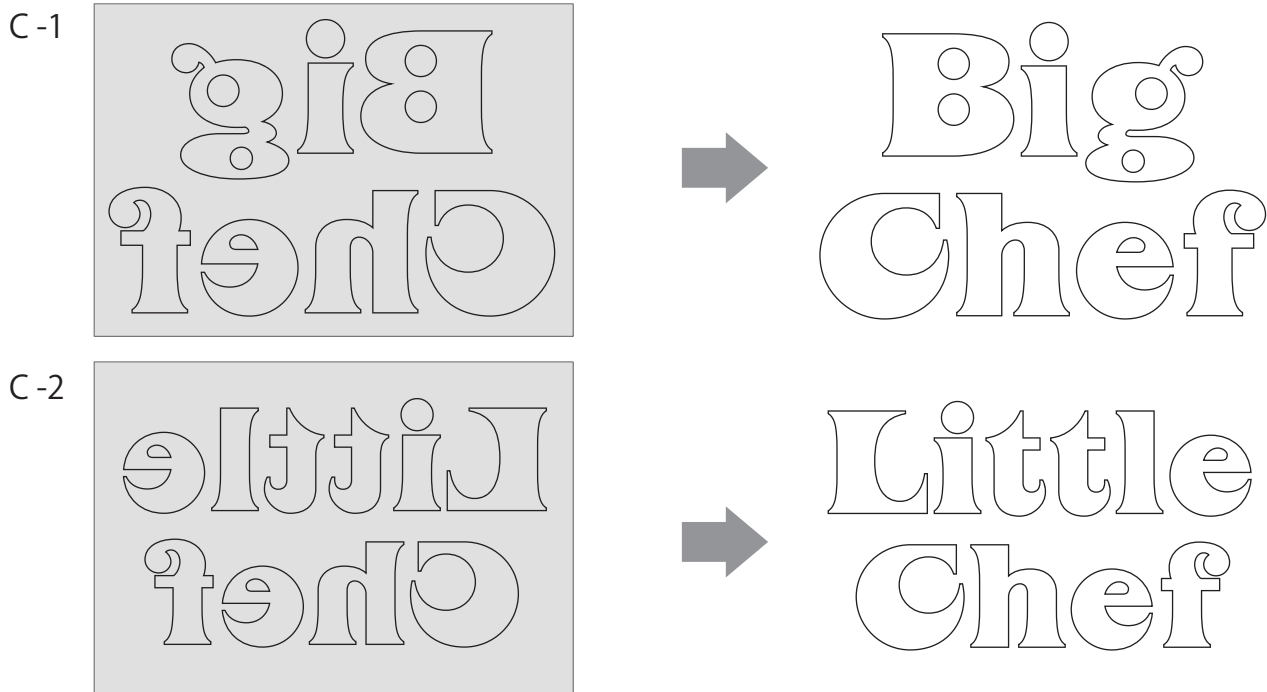
(3) Cut out parts A and the data saved in step (1).



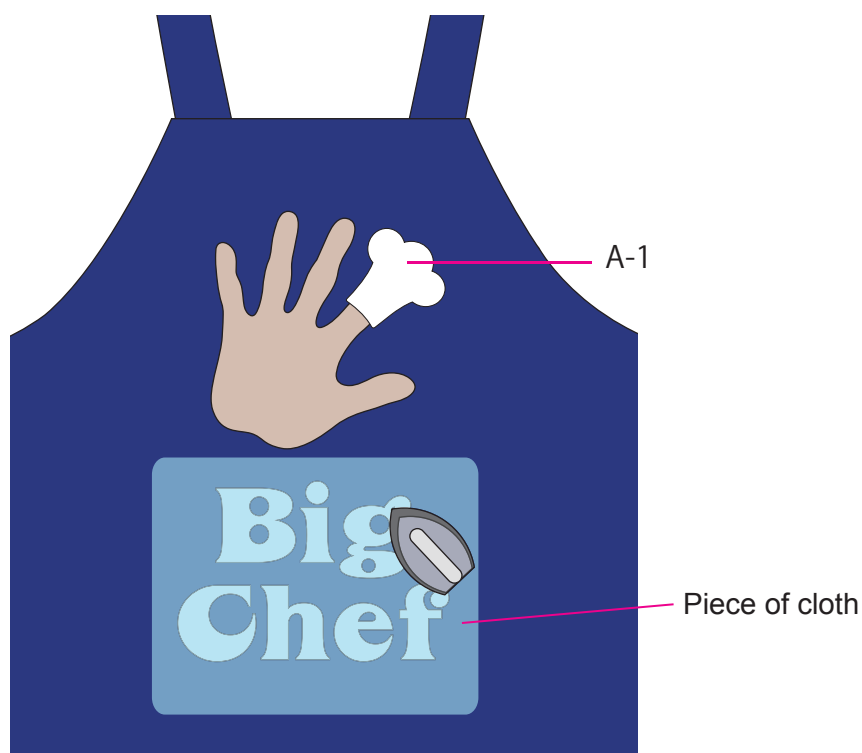
(4) With the backing of the stencil sheet facing down, attach it to the mat, and then cut parts B out of only the film. (For details on specifying settings, refer to the instructions included with the stencil sheet.)



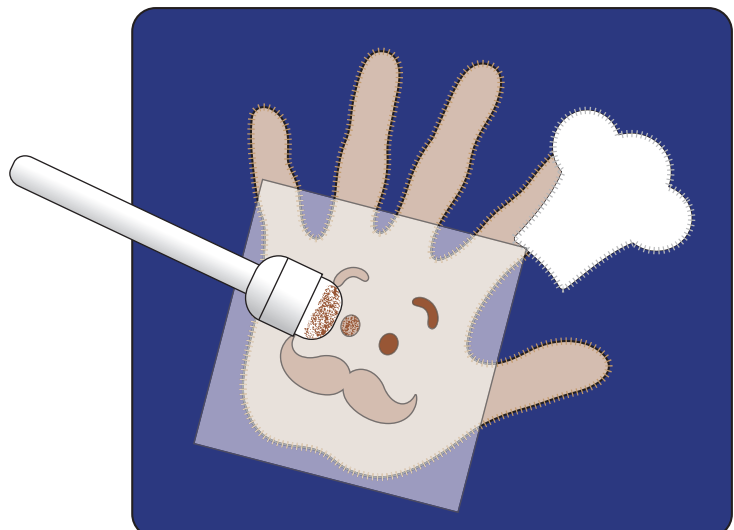
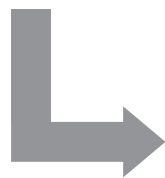
(5) With the adhesive side of the iron-on transfer sheet facing up, attach it to the mat and cut out part C. (For details, refer to the instructions included with the sheet.)



(6) Iron the pieces assembled in steps (3) and (5) in the middle of the aprons.



(7) Sew the outlines of the handprints and chef's hats with zigzag stitches (or appliqué stitches). Attach the stencil sheet as shown below, and then color it in with the fabric paint.



(8) Repeat these steps to make the child's apron.
