

000226. Easter Wall Ornament

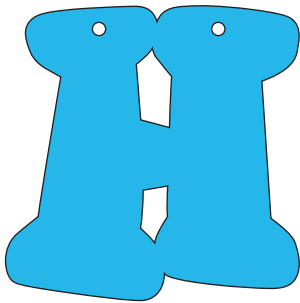


Material

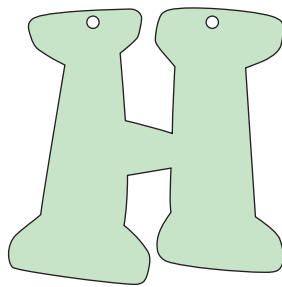
Paper/Cardstock - 9 kinds
 Wax paper (pink)
 Thin plastic sheet (0.2mm/0.008" thick, clear)
 Half pearl beads (5mm/0.2" diameter) – 10
 White dowel (10mm/0.39" diameter, 45cm/17.7" long) – 1
 Ribbon
 Nylon thread
 Foam adhesive square
 Glue or double-sided tape
 Embossing stylus or stick with rounded tip
 Rubber embossing mat or thick felt, etc.
 Thick sewing needle or awl

(1) Cut out parts A through F. Cut F-1 and F-2 from the wax paper, and F-3 from the thin plastic sheet.

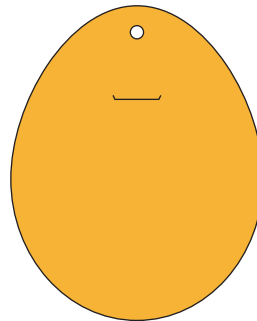

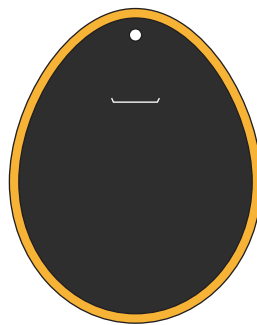


(2) Glue together parts A through D as shown below.

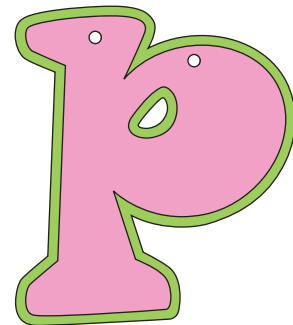

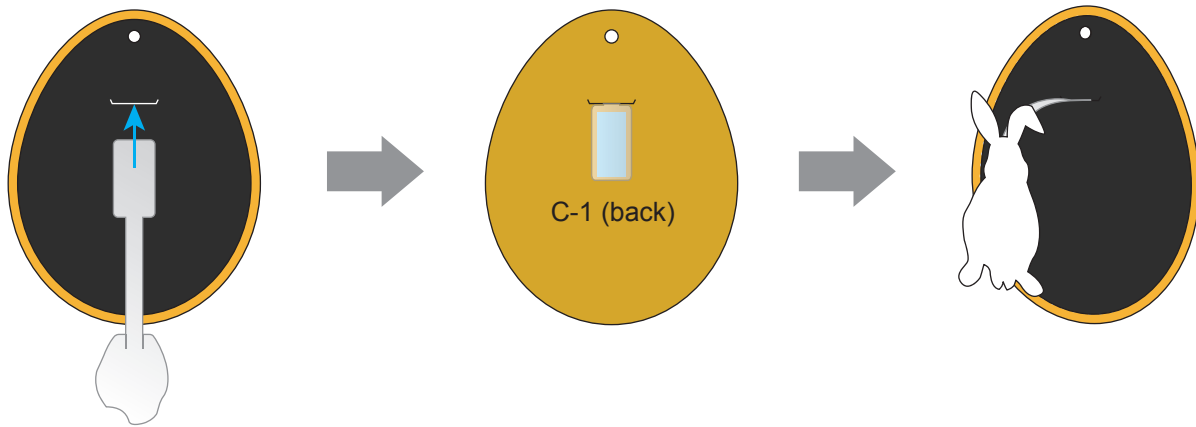
C-1 + C-2



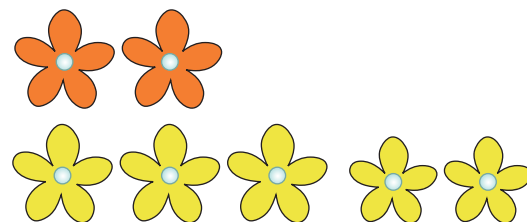
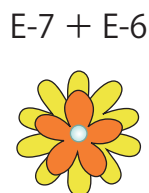
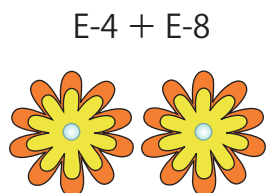
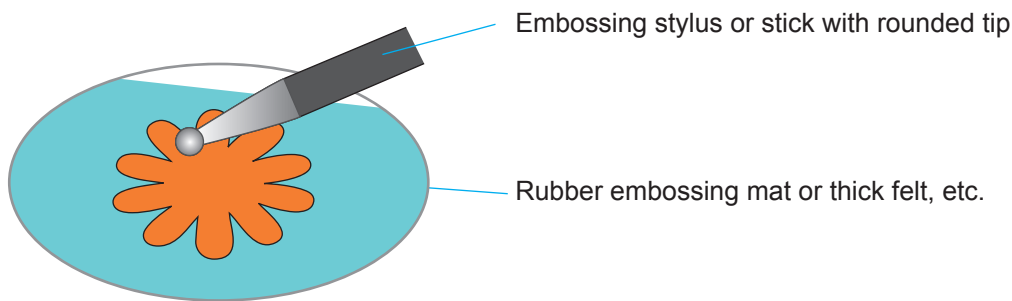

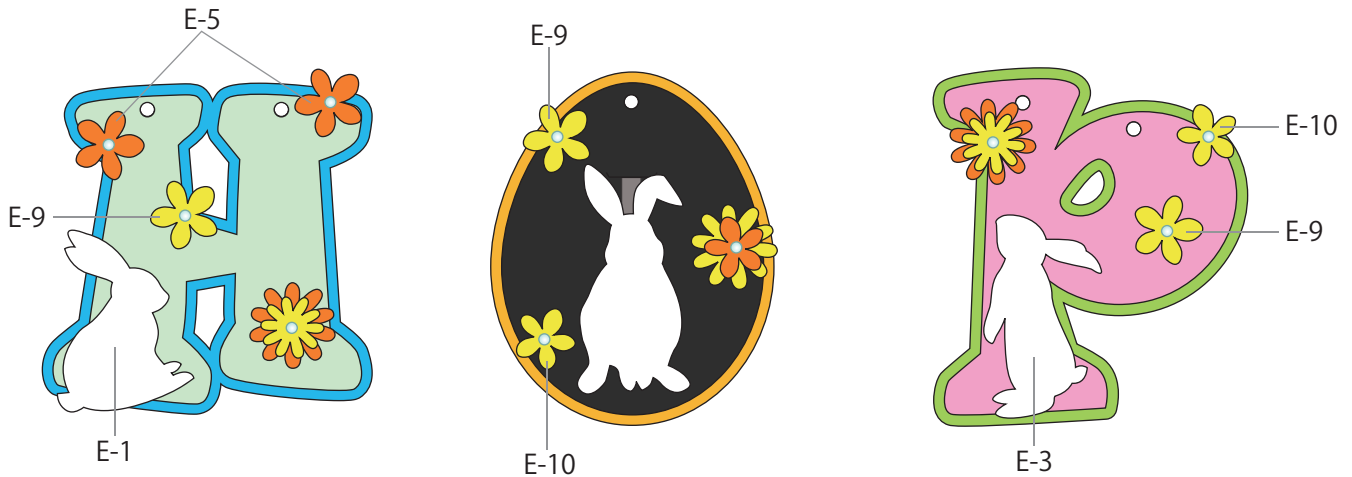
(3) Insert F-3 into the cutout of C, and then attach it at the back with double-sided tape, as shown below. Glue E-2 to the front.



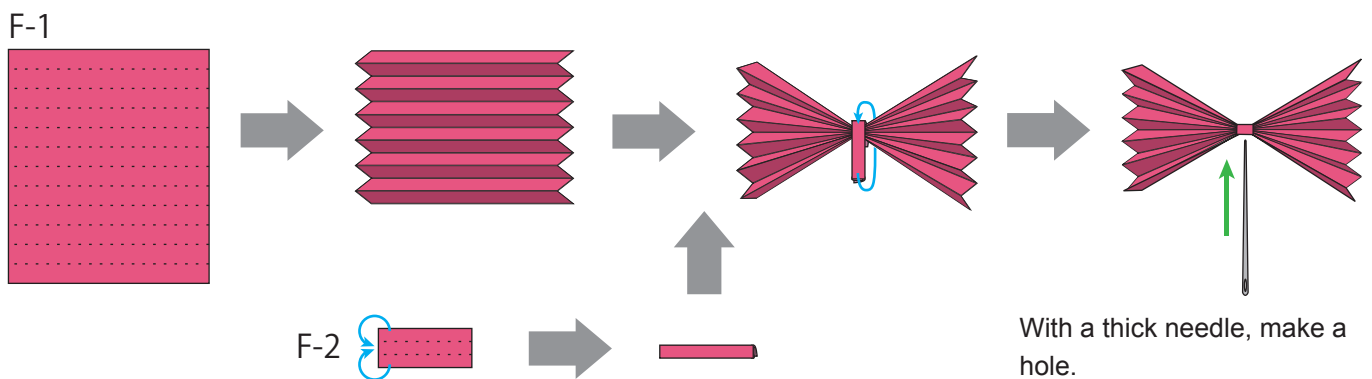
(4) Rub E-4 through E-10 with the embossing stylus to curl them, and then glue them together, as shown below. Attach a pearl bead at the center.



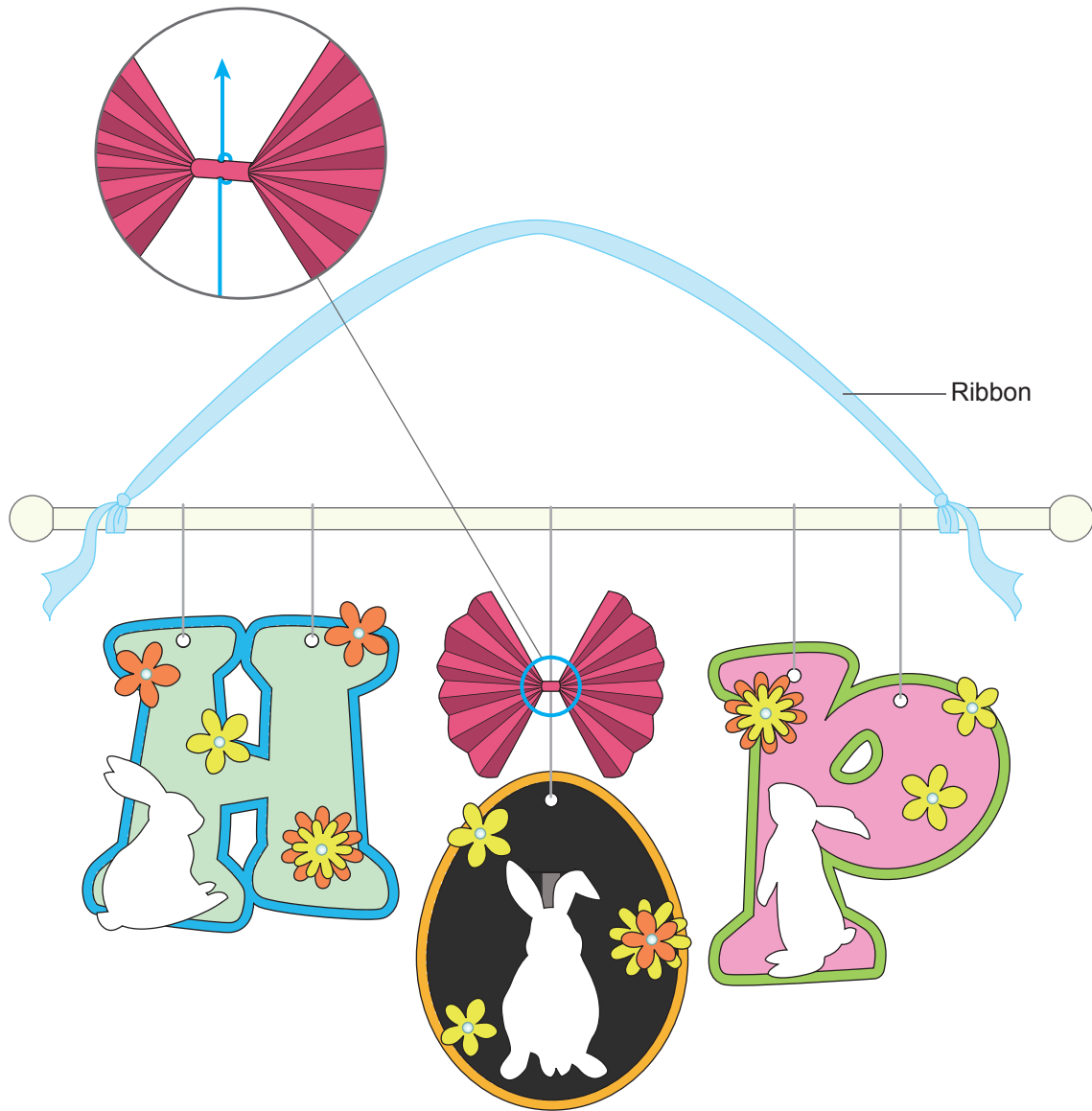
(5) Glue foam adhesive squares to the back of E-1 and E-3, and then glue together each part, as shown below.



(6) Accordion-fold F-1. Fold F-2 in three, and then wrap it around F-1 to make a bow, as shown below. With the thick sewing needle (or awl), make a hole to pass the nylon thread through.



(7) Pass nylon threads through the pieces assembled in steps (5) and (6), tie them to the dowel, and then adjust the positions of the motifs.
