

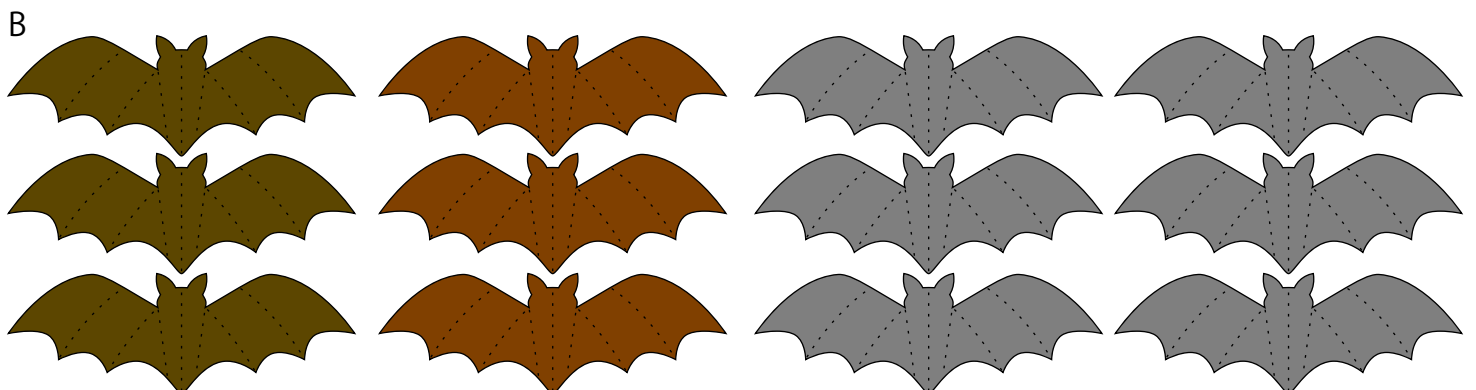
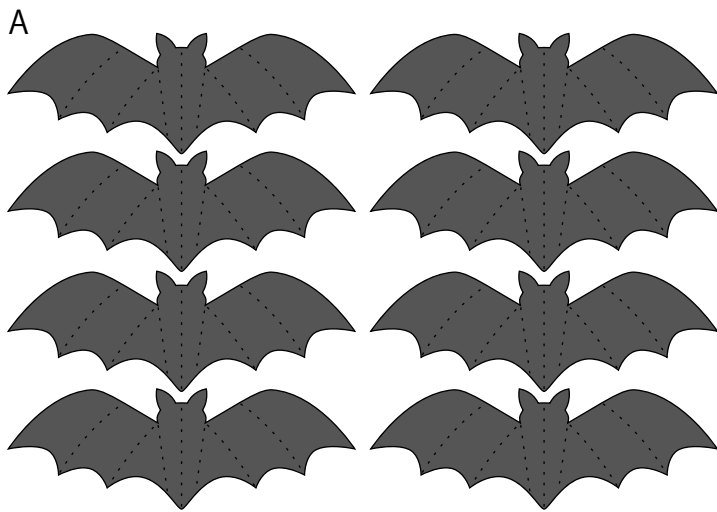
000259. Bat Wreath



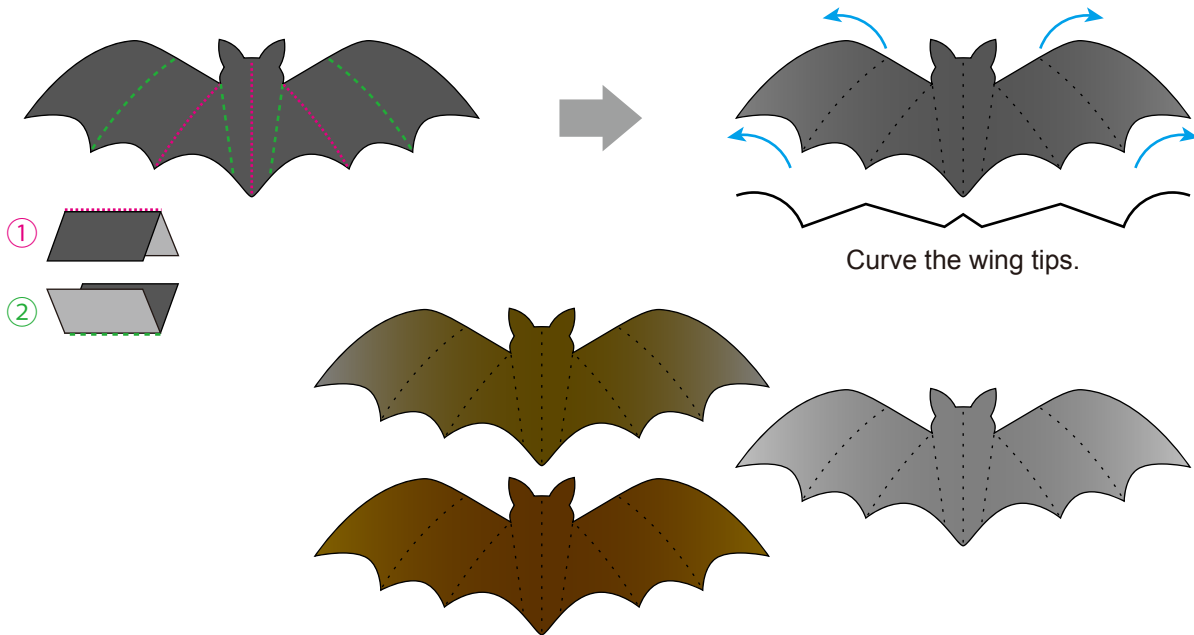
Material

- Paper/Cardstock (metallic dark gray) – 1 kind
- Patterned paper – 3 kinds
- Grapevine wreath (approx. 20 cm (7.9") diameter) – 1
- Ribbon (approx. 15 mm (0.6") wide, approx. 45 cm (17.7") long, orange) – 2
- Hemp twine – Approx. 20 cm (7.9") long
- Glue gun or craft adhesive

(1) Cut out parts A and B. Cut A from the metallic dark gray paper and B from the patterned paper for a total of 20 copies.



(2) Fold the pieces from step (1) along the dotted lines, and then curve the wing tips with your finger, as shown below.



(3) Pass the hemp twine through the wreath, and then tie the ends together, as shown below.



(4) Randomly arrange the bats prepared in step (2) over the wreath, and then glue them on with a glue gun or craft adhesive.



(5) With the two pieces of ribbon overlapping, tie them in a bow. Glue it to the hemp twine with a glue gun or craft adhesive.
