



000302. Foiled Place Card



Material (per item) Foil Transfer Starter Kit (CAFTKIT1) Paper/Cardstock - 1 kind Guest name tag (printed or hand-written)

Rhinestones (SS12) - 1

Craft adhesive

Masking tape

Scissors or craft knife


Tweezers

(Preparation) Update the software of the machine to the latest version, and activate the Foiling function (Figure 1) on the machine. For details, refer to the instructions included with the kit.



The screen that appears differs depending on the model.


(1) Refer to the illustration on the last page and make the guest name tags.




(2) Print out the "Actual-size layout pattern" on the last page. With scissors or a craft knife, cut along the black frames.



(3) Cut out A, and then attach it to the low tack adhesive mat. Place the layout pattern from step (2) on top, and then temporarily attach it, as shown below.




(4) Scan the piece from step (3) by using the background scanning function, and then align the data for foiling pattern A with the scanned image.







- (5) Remove the temporarily attached pattern, and then follow the on-screen instructions for foiling. (For details, refer to the instructions included with the kit.)
 - 1) Apply the glue.




(2) Position the foil.



3 Apply the foil.




4 Remove any excess.







(6) Fold A along the dotted lines, and then attach the rhinestone with adhesive, as shown below.




(7) Insert the name tag from step (1) into the cutouts.



[Actual-size layout pattern] Print out this page, and then use scissors to cut along the black frame. Since this will be used to position the foiling pattern, print it out at its original size, without enlarging or reducing it.
